- Commit to meet with your buddy at least 3 times a year.
- Please treat your buddy with dignity and respect.
- Please ensure that any information your buddy shares with you is not shared without their consent.
- Please behave in a professional manner.
- Please ensure that all contributions and questions are delivered with a constructive, positive approach.
- The following behaviours will not be tolerated:
 - Harassment
 - Racist, homophobic, ableist, sexist, or other discriminatory behaviour including jokes
 - Negative or exclusionary comments about any identity.

Consequences

Anyone who breaches the code of conduct may be removed from the initiative, may be barred from future Seabird Group events, and may be removed from our membership for a minimum period of one year.
