Table S1. Results of the 2023 census of the population size of Great Black-backed Gull Larus marinus breeding in Caithness. Colonies are listed clockwise from the county march at Drumhollistan. Colonies 1–12 are on the north coast, the remainder are on the east coast. Colonies 1, 3–10 & 12–13 are in the North Caithness Cliffs Special Protection Area (SPA), colonies 25-76 are in the East Caithness Cliffs SPA. Also included are colonies 77–83 which had breeding pairs in 2000–22, but which were not occupied in 2023, with the typical colony size provided instead of the number of nests observed. AON = apparently occupied nests. a = Colonies included in the annual monitoring programme (Oksien & Sellers 2023); note that two other colonies (Ceann Lethad nam Bo and Traigh Loisgte) had been used in 2022 but were unoccupied in 2023. b = nests dispersed across the northeastern part of the nuclear licenced site. c = nests in two main groups, in the northeast (ND3578) and southwest (ND3476) of the island respectively, with the others widely dispersed across the remainder of the island (ND3477/78 & ND3576/77). d = with Herring Gulls L. argentatus. e = with Great Cormorants *Phalacrocorax carbo*. f = nests c. 50 m apart. g = Cleit Bheag and nr Cleit Mhor c. 70 m apart. h = Contains correction for nests in blind spots. i = formerly there was also a large Herring Gull colony here. j = formerly there was a substantial Cormorant colony here; vacated at the same time as the Great Black-backed Gulls. k = formerly there was also a medium-sized Herring Gull colony here. I = formerly large Herring Gull colony here, which declined over the same period as the Great Black-backed Gulls declined.
